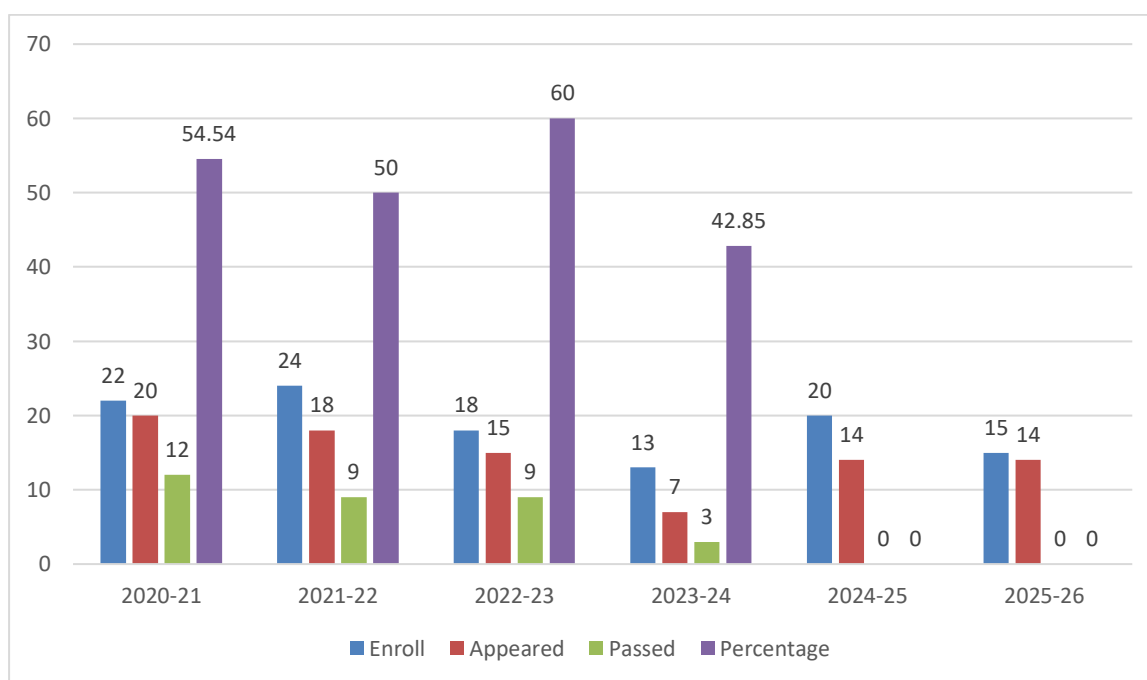
The academic performance of the students during the period 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26 is as follows.

E. **Interactive Teaching:** Using discussions, questioning and group activities.

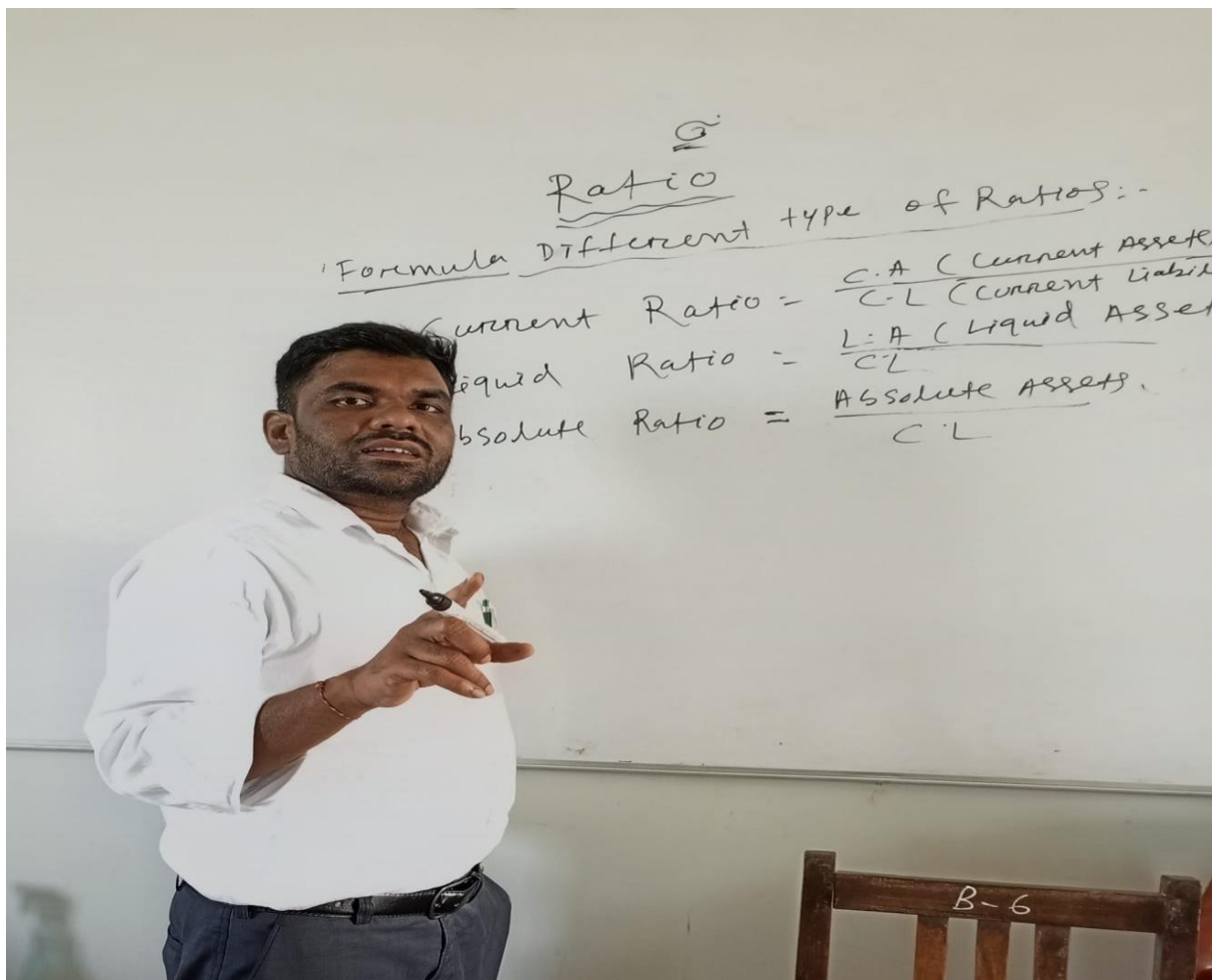
F. **Student -Centred Learning:** Encouraging active participation and interaction.

H. **Student Monitoring:** Providing academic guidance and individual support.

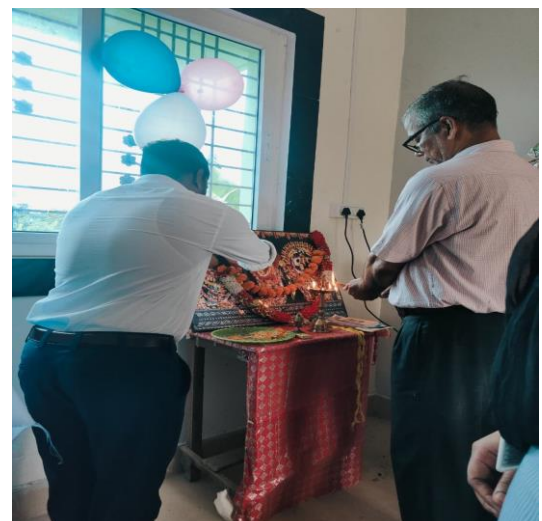


Teaching in a Classroom by Indra Madam with white board

TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

A. TEACHING: Department of Commerce is unique in teaching of commerce subject to the students of B.Com. The details of teaching practices are presented here.

1. **Lecture method:** It is a conventional and age-old practice in teaching. It is adopted for the theory and problem subjects. In the lecture methods interaction of the students is solicited in between the subject teaching.
2. **Analytical presentation method:** In B. Com there are several subjects which are problem oriented. Every faculty member follows the method of analytical presentation, which gives more subject knowledge to the students and also increases their analytical thinking.
3. **Audio Video Methods:** The students of B. Com watch a video as per their syllabus. After the lesson the concerned faculty member explains the main points of the lesson.

B. LEARNING: Learning is a quality practice in education. The department of commerce adopts feasible learning methods for sustaining the subject knowledge. Some learning methods adopted by the department are given below.

1. **Teaching Models:** For easy learning some models have been prepared by the students. These are displayed in the class room for easy learning. This specially helps the academically weak students to grasp the concepts easily and clearly.
2. **Quiz:** Subject quiz is conducted to the students. This method of learning enhances the subject knowledge and competitive spirit. This practice is giving more encouragement to fast and slow learners

C. EVALUATION: The department of commerce adopts academic activity in three-dimension way. Teaching is first dimension; better learning process is second and evaluation is third dimension. The practices of evaluation are mentioned here under.

1. **Assignment:** Every student should compulsorily submit assignment on given topic. The assignments are evaluated by the lecturers' time to time. The same topic is given for the slip test.
2. **Internal Assessment Tests:** As per the University schedule department of Commerce conducts the Internal Assessment tests twice in a semester.

- 3. Remedial Coaching:** After analyzing the unit test marks, the weak students are selected for separate coaching. Intensive coaching is given to them, running notes are also dictated in the separate class.

FACULTY IMPROVEMENT

The faculty members of the commerce department always try to develop their subject knowledge by adopting the advance academic learning through research. The details of faculty improvement activities are given below.

1. PURCHASING LATEST BOOKS:

Every year M/S VK Global Publications, Hyderabad, Kalyani Publishing house, Hyderabad give latest books to the staff members of the department. Faculty members also purchase subject books personally for better preparation.

2. SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE:

Faculty members regularly update their subject knowledge in accordance with the latest curriculum, syllabus, and developments in their respective subjects. They refer to new books, study materials, journals, and other academic resources for continuous improvement.

3. TEACHING METHODOLOGY:

Faculty members adopt modern, interactive, and student-centred teaching methods according to the needs and learning levels of students. Various teaching techniques are used to make classroom teaching more effective and interesting.

4. PARTICIPATION IN SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS:

Faculty members participate in seminars, workshops, conferences, and other academic programmes. These activities provide opportunities to gain new knowledge, exchange ideas, and improve academic and professional skills.

5. USE OF DIGITAL RESOURCES:

Faculty members make use of computers, the internet, e-books, online journals, digital study materials, and other educational resources. These resources help in updating knowledge and improving the teaching-learning process.

INFRASTRUCTURE

1. **Staff Room:** Common Staff Room with attached toilet facilities is provided. Facilities available include AC room with all facilities are available.
2. **Departmental Library:** Department of commerce has no separate library but, 70-80 books are in our department for both staff and students. It possesses books on subjects like Accountancy, Management, Banking, Statistics, Business Law, Cost Accounting, FASR, Corporate Accounting, Income Tax, Management Accounting, Auditing etc,. Books on personality development, Reasoning for competitive exams are also available. The students are allowed to read in the allotted place of the department.
3. **Class rooms:** There are two separate class rooms for commerce with white board with sufficient furniture. All the class rooms are ventilated and properly illuminated. A Computer system also for Commerce department with Tally Programme Software is available.

- The students are grouped and placed under a teacher to develop close rapport to solve the personal problems of each student.
- The department also maintaining ward counseling register.
- Students are encouraged to do PG and prepare competitive exams of their choice.
